SELECTION OF PRINCIPAL (REGULAR), TGT (REGULAR & CONTRACTUAL), HM (REGULAR), PRT (REGULAR), NTT (REGULAR) & OFFICE SUPDT (REGULAR), ACCTS ASST (REGULAR), CLERK (REGULAR), LAB ATTENDANT (REGULAR) AND HELPER (CONTRACTUAL) AT AIR FORCE SCHOOL TEZPUR

1. AF School Tezpur invites application for the above said posts. The appointment will be done in accordance to Education Code 2020 and policies in vogue. Last date of receiving of application forms is **13 Feb 2026** at AF School Tezpur. The vacancies and minimum qualifications required for said posts are given below:-

1.1 Principal

Mandatory Qualifications

1.1.1 **Academic Qualification.** Masters Degree, with a minimum aggregate of 50 percent, from any University recognised by the Govt of India/UGC/AICTE. The Masters Degree should be in any one of the subjects taught in the Secondary classes (English, Hindi, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies and Computer Science) of that Air Force School. Those holding a Masters Degree in any other subject will not be eligible for the post.

1.1.2 **Professional Qualification.** A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

1.1.3 **Experience.** Teaching experience of at least two years as a PGT/TGT or experience of at least two years as Principal of a Secondary or a Primary Air Force School.

1.1.4 Age.

1.1.4.1 Should be in the age group of 35 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled. There will be no upper age limit in the case of serving staff of Air Force Schools but they should have at least two years of residual service as on 01 July of the academic year in which they are being considered for the post.

1.1.4.2 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

1.1.4.3 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.1.4.4 Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

1.1.5 **Language.** Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

Desirable Qualifications

1.1.6 Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.1.7 Conversant with POCSO Act, CBSE rules, NCERT etc.

1.1.8 Attended educational workshops.

1.1.9 Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

1.1.10 CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

1.2. Trained Graduate Teachers (TGT)

Mandatory Qualifications

1.2.1. A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt. of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as under :-

1.2.1.1 TGT (English): English as an elective subject at Degree level.

1.2.1.2. TGT (Sanskrit): Sanskrit as an elective subject at Degree level.

1.2.1.3. TGT (Hindi): Hindi as an elective subject at Degree level.

1.2.1.4 TGT (Social Studies): Any two out of History, Geography, Economics or Political Science, of which one must be either History or Geography.

1.2.1.5 TGT (Maths): Maths with any two out of Physics, Chemistry, Electronics, Computer Science or Statistics.

1.2.1.6 TGT (Science): Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany and Zoology (Any three subjects should have been studied).

1.2.1.7 TGT Health Wellness Teacher: Diploma in Counseling from a Teacher recognized University.

Or

BA/ BSc Psychology with Educational Psychology/ Counseling Psychology from a recognized University

Or

MA/ MSc in Counseling Psychology or MA MSc Psychology with Counseling Psychology as specialization

Or

MA/MSc in Applied Psychology with Counseling Psychology from a recognized University

1.2.1.8 TGT (Computer): PGDCA/MCA/BE from any Govt recognized Institution.

1.2.2 A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college / university recognized by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education. However, B.Ed. degree is not mandatory for the post of TGT (Computers), TGT (Music), TGT (Games), TGT (Drawing), TGT (Librarian) and Health Wellness Teacher.

1.2.3 Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.2.4 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

1.2.5 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.2.6 Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

1.2.7 Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except TGT Hindi, Sanskrit, Games and Drawing).

Desirable Qualifications

1.2.8 Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.2.9 Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

1.2.10 CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

1.3. **TGT (Special Educator):** Graduate with B.Ed (Special Education).

OR

B.Ed (General) with one year Diploma in Special Education

OR

B.Ed (General) with two years Diploma in Special Education

OR

B.Ed (General) with Post Graduate Professional Diploma in Special Education (PGPD)

OR

B.Ed Special Education and Post Graduate Professional Certificate in Special Education (PGPC)

OR

PG Diploma in Special Education (Mental Retardation)

OR

PG Diploma in Special Education (Multiple Disabilities: Physical & Neurological)

OR

PG Diploma in Special Education (Locomotors Impairment and Cerebral Palsy)

OR

Secondary level Teacher Training Course in Visual Impairment

OR

Senior Diploma in Teaching the Deaf

OR

BA B.Ed in Visual Impairment

OR

Any other equivalent qualification approved by RCI

Note:

1.3.1 Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs' run by CBR Network in affiliation with Bangalore University will be considered only up to five years from the date of issue of this order for consideration of qualification for Special Education Teacher.

1.3.2 Teachers with qualification/s in single disability area will be encouraged to undergo cross disability courses for taking care of wide range of diversities in a general school.

1.4 TGT (Librarian)

1.4.1 University degree in Library Science or graduate with one year diploma in Library Science from a Govt recognised institution.

1.4.2 Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.4.3 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

1.4.4 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall

be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.4.5 Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

1.4.6 Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.

1.4.7 Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.5 **Headmaster/Headmistress Middle/Primary School**

Mandatory Qualifications

1.5.1 **Academic Qualification.** Graduate Degree, with a minimum aggregate of 50 percent, from any University recognised by the Govt of India/UGC/AICTE. The Graduate Degree should be in any one of the subjects taught in the Middle/ Primary classes of that Air Force School. Those holding a graduate degree in any other subject will not be eligible. However, if such candidate holds a Masters Degree in any of the subjects taught in the School, he/she will be eligible for the post.

1.5.2 **Professional Qualification.** A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/ National Council of Teachers Education.

1.5.3 **Experience.** Teaching experience of at least two years as a PGT/TGT/ PRT or at least three years as a NTT or experience of at least two years as Principal/HM of an Air Force School.

1.5.4 **Age**

1.5.4.1 Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled. There will be no upper age limit in the case of serving staff of Air Force Schools but they should have at least two years of residual service as on 01 July of the academic year in which they are being considered for the post.

1.5.4.2 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

1.5.4.3 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.5.4.4 Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/ TGT or three years as a PRT or NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

1.5.4.5 Language. Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

Desirable Qualifications.

1.5.5 Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.5.6 Conversant with POCSO Act, CBSE rules, NCERT etc.

1.5.7 Attended educational workshops.

1.5.8 Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

1.5.9 CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

1.6. Primary Teachers (PRT)

Mandatory Qualifications

1.6.1 Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name know) from a recognized board.

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B El Ed).

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Education (Special education).

Or

Graduation with at least 50 % marks and Bachelor of Education (B Ed) from any NCTE recognized institution along with six-month Bridge Course in Elementary Education recognized by the NCTE.

1.6.2 Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.6.3 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation up to a maximum of five years.

1.6.4 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.6.5 Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

1.6.6 Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

Desirable Qualifications.

1.6.7 Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.6.8 Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

1.6.9 CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

1.7 Primary Teacher (Games)

Mandatory Qualifications

1.7.1 Bachelor in Physical Education (B.P.Ed/BPE) from a recognized university.

Or

Bachelor's degree with Physical Education as an elective subject with 50% marks.

Or

Bachelor's degree with Physical Education as an elective subject with 45% marks and participation in National or State or Inter University competition in sports or games or athletics recognized by Association of Indian University or Indian Olympics Association.

Or

Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and participated in national or state or Inter-University sports or games or athletics.

1.7.2 Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.7.3 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation up to a maximum of five years.

1.7.4 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.7.5 Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

1.7.6 Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

Desirable Qualifications

1.7.7 Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.7.8 Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

1.7.9 CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

1.8 Primary Teacher (Drawing)

Mandatory Qualifications

1.8.1 A Bachelor's Degree from any University recognized by the Govt of India/UGC/AICTE, with minimum marks of 50 percent in the aggregate.

1.8.2 Diploma in Drawing and Painting/ Sculpture/ Graphic Art from any Govt recognised institution

Or

Four years' Diploma in Fine Arts and Crafts from Viswa Bharati, Shanti Niketan

Or

Diploma in Fine Arts from Govt. School of Arts and Crafts, Patna

Or

M.A. in Drawing and Painting from Agra University, Agra

Or

Degree/ Diploma in Fine Arts from Regional Colleges of Education.

1.8.3 Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.8.4 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation up to a maximum of five years.

1.8.5 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.8.6 Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

1.8.7 Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

Desirable Qualifications

1.8.10 CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

1.9 Primary Teacher (Music)

Mandatory Qualifications

1.9.1 Degree in Music from a Govt recognised University.

Or

Higher Secondary with any of the following, viz., Sangeet Visharad of Gandharva Mahavidyalaya Mumbai.

Or

Bhatkhande Sangeet Vidyapeeth, Lucknow OR Indira Kala Sangeet Vishwavidyalaya, Khairagarh (Chhattisgarh).

Or

Sangeet Prabhakar Examination of Prayag Sangeet Samiti, Allahabad.

Or

Equivalent qualification from other Govt recognised institutions.

Or

Degree/Diploma awarded by Pracheen Kala Kendra, Chandigarh in the following categories, viz., Sangeet Bhaskar with graduation in any discipline, Sangeet/ Nritya Bhushan with graduation in any discipline, Sangeet Bhushan with Sr Sec/ Sec/ Pt I of three-year degree course and Sangeet/ Nritya Visharad with Sr Sec/ Sec/ Pt I of three-year degree course.

1.9.2 Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.9.3 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation up to a maximum of five years.

1.9.4 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

Mandatory Qualifications

1.10.1 Senior Secondary with Nursery Teachers Training diploma or diploma in Nursery/Montessori/Pre-Primary Teachers Training or Diploma in Elementary Education from a Govt recognized institution. While candidates with higher qualifications may apply, preference is to be given to candidates with diploma in Nursery/Montessori Training.

1.10.2 Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.10.3 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

1.10.4 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.10.5 Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT/PRT/ or three years as NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

Desirable Qualifications

1.10.7 Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.10.8 Should be able to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

1.10.9 Experience in art, craft, cartoon, caricature, puppet making, music, dance etc.

1.11 Office Superintendent (Erstwhile Adm Officer)

1.11.1 Graduate with at least five years' experience in office work.

1.11.2 Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.11.3 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

1.11.4 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed

the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.11.5 Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

1.11.6 Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

1.11.7 Basic knowledge of computer typing and applications, especially MS Office.

1.12 **Accounts Assistant**

1.12.1 B Com from a Govt recognised University with knowledge of accounts and book-keeping.

1.12.2 Typing speed of at least 40 wpm in English.

1.12.3 Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.12.4 Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.12.5 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

1.12.6 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.12.7 Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

1.13.1 Graduate from a Govt recognised University.

1.13.2 Typing speed of at least 40 wpm in English.

1.13.3 Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.13.4 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

1.13.5 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.13.6 Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be so eligible.

1.13.7 Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.

1.13.8 Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

1.14 **Lab Attendant**

1.14.1 10+2 with Science.

1.14.2 Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.14.3 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

1.14.4 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.14.5 Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be eligible for the same.

1.14.6 Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English or Hindi.

1.15 **Helper**

1.15.1 Only the following categories of Helpers (erstwhile Multi-Tasking Staff) are to be employed as per the scale authorized as per Para 7(d), Chapter 4. Henceforth, only the following trade categories of Helpers are permitted:

- 1.15.1.1 Ayah
- 1.15.1.2 Peon
- 1.15.1.3 Gardener
- 1.15.1.4 Sweeper

1.15.2 No educational qualifications are laid down. However, candidates should be selected keeping in view suitability for trade duties.

1.15.3 Should be in the age group of 21 to 40 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

1.15.4 Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

1.15.5 Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

1.15.6 Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years.

1.15.7 BOO must satisfy itself about the genuineness of the date of birth of the candidates.
